What is Oobleck? It is a non-Newtonian fluid.

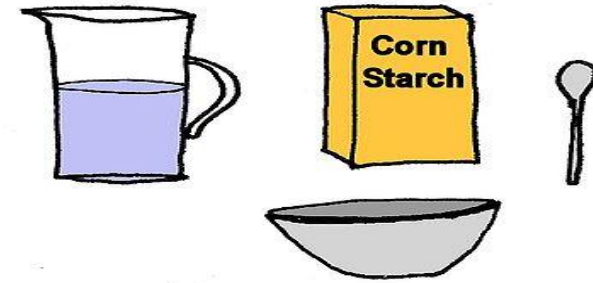
What does that mean? It means that it is not a liquid or a solid.

### *Ingredients:*

*2 cups cornstarch*

*1 cup water*

*Food coloring (optional)*

Mix the cornstarch and water until your oobleck is formed.

You may need to add more/less of either ingredient to reach the right consistency.

*Tip: If you would like to color your oobleck, add food coloring to your water and then mix with the cornstarch.*



**Pick up the oobleck with your hands and form a ball.**

**Then let go of the ball and watch it melt into your hands.**

**Ooey...gooey...very cool!!!**
