Adult Supervision Required

Children must ALWAYS be under the direct supervision of a caregiver.



Respect for Others & Museum Property

Be respectful of each other and the museum's exhibits.



Share & Put Away

Please share exhibit spaces, play materials, and put away after play.



Seek Staff Assistance When Needed

We are here to HELP! Contact BCCM staff immediately with any questions, needs, or concerns.

The following are PROHIBITED at BCCM:

- Use of profane, threatening or abusive language or physical aggression
- Clothing displaying profane or obscene words or graphics
- Firearms, weapons of any kind, toy or replica firearms or weapons, or hazardous materials
- No alcohol, smoking, electronic vapes, tobacco/nicotine or cannabis products
- Disorderly conduct or actions that may bring harm or danger to others
- Defacing, damaging, or destroying Museum exhibits or property
- Pets, except for qualified ADA Service Animals
- Eating and/or drinking within exhibit areas

BCCM reserves the right to refuse admission, revoke membership, and remove any individual who violates this Visitor Code of Conduct, or poses a risk of damage to people or property, without refund.

BCCM is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged personal property.
